- 1 three ring binder (1" or 1 ½", sturdy binder, no large zipper ones)
- 1 package subject dividers with 5+ tabs
- 5 Duotangs preferred colours are 1 navy/dark blue, green, red, yellow, black
- 2 pocket folders
- 1-2 packages of looseleaf (lined writing paper, approximately 200 sheets)
- 1 package of graph paper (1cm if possible)
- 5 coil notebooks with lined paper (curly spine, 80+ pages)
- lead pencils (30 minimum HB and sharpened are best)
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 2 white pencil erasers
- 1 pen
- 1 highlighter
- 1 package of colouring markers (not permanent, unscented)
- 1 package of coloured pencils
- 1-2 packages of dry erase/whiteboard markers
- 2 large glue sticks (or 3-4 smaller ones) and 1 bottle of white glue
- 1 zipper pouch (dollar store is fine) for homework items
- 1 protractor for math (a full math set is <u>not</u> needed) →
- Headphones/earbuds (small/inexpensive pair kept at school)
- Indoor sneakers to help keep our halls, classrooms, and gym clean a



Other helpful items (please feel free to reuse items from previous years)

- 1 whiteboard eraser (or old sock or glove)
- scissors
- ruler (30cm)
- 1 package of reinforcements for paper
- 1 clipboard (dollar store is fine)
- French/English Dictionary
- Bescherelle: L'art de conjuguer (#1) OR 501 French Verbs (student preference)
- 1 Art sketch pad (dollar store is fine)
- 1 sharpie/permanent marker
- 1 zippered pencil case or regular sized pencil box (to store colouring supplies and pencils)

- Some items (pencils, whiteboard markers, etc.) may need to be replenished throughout the year. Feel free to send some initially and keep others at home for later.
